

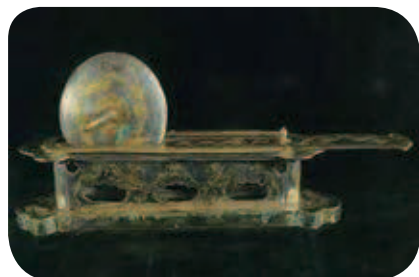


WELCOME TO OUR ANNUAL EXTENDED SEPTEMBER EDITION
